### Position Description Summary:

NetHope is seeking an experienced, enterprising and energetic data analytics and information management professional to lead its efforts to build a strong crisis informatics program. The position will also lead information management initiatives that will serve the organization's programs and NGO members.

Since NetHope works as a virtual team, the IMCI Director must be adept at working independently, reaching out to build team engagement, building and bridging communications in a virtual environment, and adapting to distributed processes and workflows. This position reports to the Vice President, Global Programs.

### Key responsibilities include:

#### Information Management

- Advance NetHope member data sharing in support of NetHope programs.
- Advance the ability of NetHope member NGOs to better utilize data through the development, adoption and scale of best practices and standards related data capture, information management and data visualization.
- Contribute to NetHope's efforts to become a data-driven organization that sets the bar for what it means to be a digital nonprofit.

### **Informatics**

- Direct NetHope's Crisis Informatics program to meet immediate member, donor and NetHope needs for data-driven decisions during emergency response scenarios.
- Building on the success of the Crisis Informatics work, develop a sustainable informatics model for NetHope, including design, funding and operational planning.

### **Member Programs**

- Significantly contribute to the Data for Disaster Preparedness program specifically around work streams related to data sharing, crisis informatics, data preparedness and best practices for incident response.
- Contribute data capture, information management and data visualization expertise to NetHope member programs as the need is identified.
